DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1, Monday 16th May UK/Bethlehem

Depart London Luton with easyJet direct to Tel Aviv Ben-Gurion Airport. Upon arrival coach transfer to our hotel in Bethlehem. Evening dinner in our hotel and overnight.

Day 2, Tuesday 17th May Bethlehem/Shepherds' Fields

From the hotel, we walk to Manger Square and immediately we visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born (to avoid long queue and huge crowds) and follow with a Mass in St Joseph's Grotto. Afterwards we tour the Basilica of the Nativity, visiting St Catherine's church, St Joseph's Grotto and St Jerome Tomb. Afterwards we walk to the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. Lunch at the Square. Coach to Shepherd's field, visit Grottos there and Chapel above - where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. We sing Carols here. Proceed to Ein Karem and visit the Visitation Shrine and the Birthplace of St John the Baptist. Return to our hotel and dinner here.

Day 3, Wednesday 18th May Jerusalem (Old City)

Coach to Jerusalem, arrive in St Stephens Gate and proceed to St Anne's church, the birthplace of our Lady, and the Pool of Bethesda. Proceed to Basilica of Ecce Homo, visit Pilate's Court, Crowning with Thorns and the Condemnation Chapels, followed by Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa (a Cross is available to carry if desired) and ending in the Holy Sepulchre Basilica (the holiest place for Catholics). Mass in the Chapel of Apparition. We continue our guided tour here and visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of the Resurrection, Blessed Sacrament Chapel and the True Cross. We walk to St Peter's in Galllicantu - a truly incredible Shrine - and see the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Walk to Mt Zion and visit the Upper room and King David's Tomb then on to Dormition Abbey where our Lady was assumed to heaven. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 4, Thursday 19th May Jerusalem-Mt of Olives /Ein Karem

Coach to the summit of the Mt of Olives in Jerusalem and visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto, where Jesus taught His Prayer, Our Father. We then walk to Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. We celebrate Mass here and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and the Basilica of the Agony (the Church of All Nations) to view the Rock of the Agony and we spend a few minutes here for prayer/reflection. We have lunch here and afterwards coach to Ein Karem and the Visitation Shrine of Our Lady to St Elizabeth, then move on to visit the Basilica of St John the Baptist and visit the chapel where he was born. Return to our hotel and dinner here.

Day 5, Friday 20th May Jerusalem/Bethany/Jericho/Dead Sea

After breakfast, coach to Jerusalem and we first visit the Western Wall which is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in AD70. This is the holiest place for Jews. Continue to Bethany and visit St Lazarus's Church - the house of Lazarus, Martha and Mary and Mass here. Proceed to Jericho to view the Mt of Temptation and Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree. Lunch in Qumran or Jericho. Proceed to the Dead Sea for the floating experience. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 6, Saturday 21st May Mt Tabor/Nazareth/Cana

We say goodbye to Bethlehem and drive along the Jordan Valley to Mt Tabor - the church of Transfiguration. Taxis up to the summit and we tour here. Proceed to Nazareth and on to the magnificent Annunciation Basilica that dominates the skyline of Nazareth. We visit the Grotto where the Annunciation took place and we give you time to reflect and pray in front of the Grotto. We then move on to visit St Joseph's Grotto and his workshop. Walking across the road we visit the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. Proceed to Cana where Jesus performed his first miracles. Mass here and renewal of married Vows. Check in to our hotel in Tiberias. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 7, Sunday 22nd May Tiberias/Sea of Galilee/Capernaum/St Peter's Primacy/Mt Beatitudes)

Leave the hotel and proceed to the River Jordan for renewal of our Baptismal Vows. Continue to Tiberias and we will have a sail on the Sea of Galilee in an ancient re-production boat. Afterwards drive to Capernaum (the town of Jesus) viewing St Peter's Church and the remains of the ancient Synagogue in which Jesus used to teach. We view other ancient

remains here. We also visit the Mt of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place and admire the incredible view of the Sea of Galilee. Proceed to St Peter's Primacy, where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His resurrection and we celebrate Mass here. We then drive to the Multiplication Shrine, where Jesus multiplied a few fish and 5 loaves to feed 5,000. Return to hotel for dinner.

Day 8, Monday 23rd May Mt Carmel/Nazareth

We checkout of the hotel and head towards Haifa and visit Mt Carmel - the Basilica of Our Lady Star of the Sea - Carmelite Headquarters. We view the Cave of Prophet Elijah and we celebrate Mass here. Along the way we stop and view the impressive Bahá'í gardens and temple. This is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Depending on the time-of-flight departure, we may stop in Jaffa (Tel Aviv) to visit St Peter's Church in Tel Aviv. Proceed to the airport for our flight back to London.
