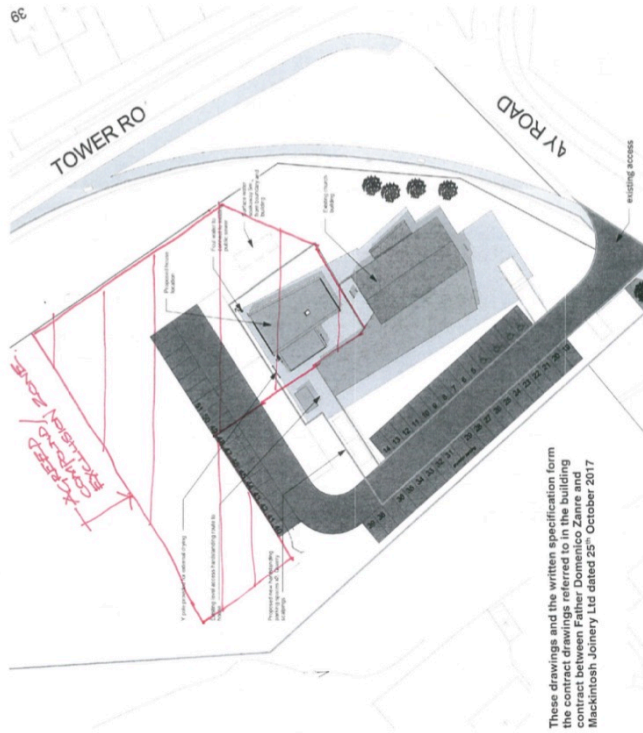

There is another date to note in the diary. Work is due to commence on the house plot and nursery contemporaneously, thus reducing disturbance and intrusion to the car park.
